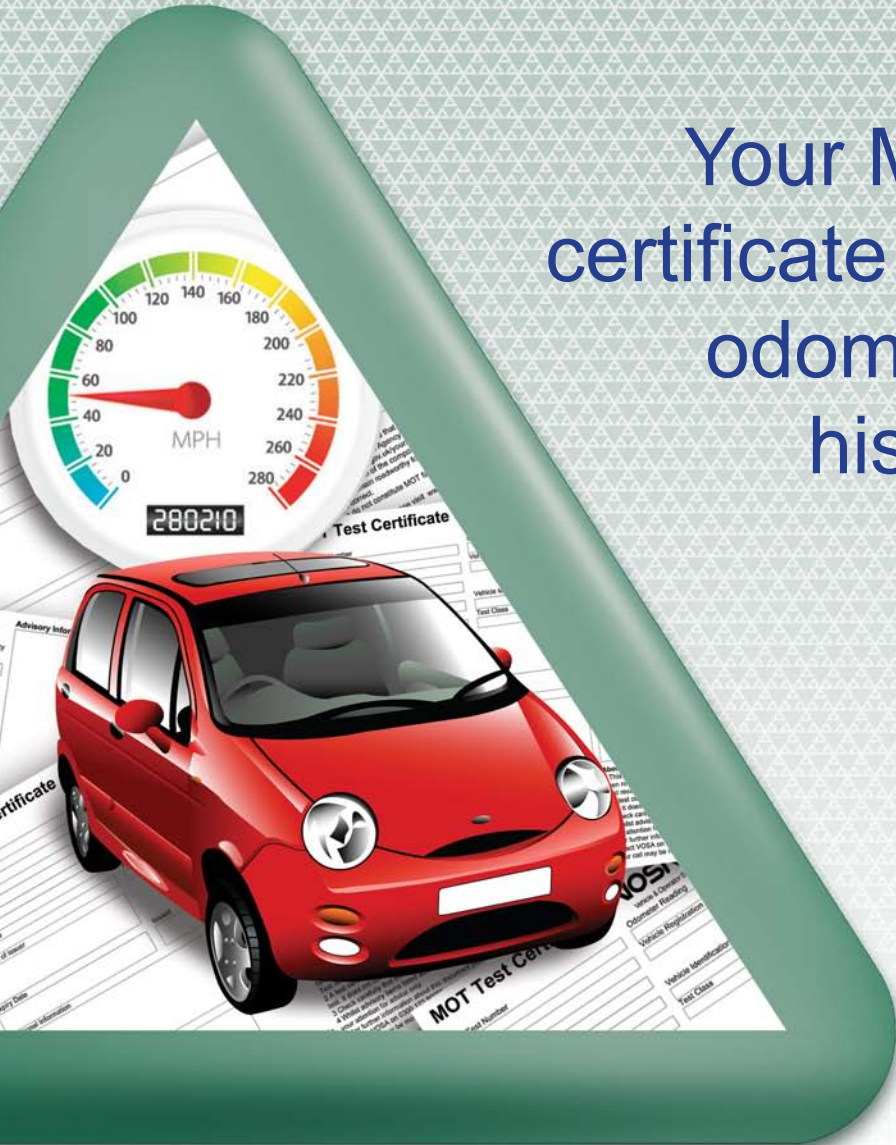

# Your MOT certificate and odometer history

If your MOT test was conducted on or after **18 November 2012** the MOT certificate will now show the vehicle's recent mileage history. This has been introduced as part of a government initiative to reduce vehicle crime. Where available, the mileage history will compose of the readings associated with the three most recent VT20s (test passes) along with the dates of those readings.

This will be in addition to the mileage reading recorded at the time of the current test.

It is important that you check all details on your MOT certificate at the time of issue so that any errors can be rectified. If you find a mistake in the mileage reading recorded for the current test, the MOT garage that conducted the test will be able to correct the error **within seven days** of the test and issue a replacement certificate.

Where an earlier recorded mileage is higher than a later one this could be caused by for example a speedometer replacement or a mistake by the Tester at the time of recording the reading. Alternatively it might suggest evidence of previous 'clocking' or tampering of the vehicle's mileage.

Please note that if there is an error in one or more of the previous mileage readings then this **cannot** be changed.
